 prayer times and to be a prayer captain ONLINE and it is very user
 friendly!

To sign-up online for a prayer time or to be a prayer captain, go to
prayer.marysvillefumc.org and click on the Sign Up link at the top of
 the page. You **do have** to create an account to be able to sign-up for a
 prayer time or to be a prayer captain. The required information needed to
 register is: your name, phone # and email address. This information is not
 visible to anyone but the prayer captain who has been approved during
 your prayer time and is for the purpose of communicating with you about
 your prayer slot, i.e., giving you phone reminders. After you have signed
 up click on the **Prayer Dates** link and then click on the **August 2nd –**
August 9th date and you will then be able to sign up for a time slot (or
 several) to either pray or be a prayer captain!

VOLUNTEERS AND WATER NEEDED FOR UNION COUNTY FAIR

The Union County Fair is scheduled July 27 - August 2, 2009. We will have 2 booths this year to represent Marysville First. If you have been part of the water distribution in the past, we will continue that ministry as well as providing a separate booth with interactive items similar to the 24/7 prayer room. We need volunteers to man both booths in 2 hour shifts. In the water booth, you will be handing out ice cold water and literature about the church. In the prayer booth, you will be explaining the various prayer areas and offering guidance in how to utilize the space. The sign up sheets are on the Outreach bulletin board if you would like to volunteer to help in either booth. In addition, we need help taking cases of water and ice daily to the fairgrounds from the church. If you can help with this at any time throughout the fair, please contact the church fair booth organizers. If you cannot volunteer, but would still like to contribute to the ministry, we are also asking for donations of cases of water (16.9 oz or 20 oz bottles) to be used for the fair.
